This is an example of a skull cap. It's the Charles Owen Young Riders Jockey skull cap. If you are purchasing this style of hat you should have it fitted at a saddlery shop by a qualified hat fitter. Price £50 - £60. You can also buy fun coloured hat covers (called silks) separately, to brighten up your child's riding hat.
